





- 1.10th A great prophet has risen in our midst. God has visited his people.
- 2.11th God loved us and sent us his <u>Son</u> as expiation for our <u>sins</u>.
- 3.12th My sheep hear my voice, says the Lord; I know them, and they follow me.
- 4.13th Speak, Lord, your servant is <u>listening</u>; You have the words of everlasting <u>life</u>.
- 5.14th Let the peace of Christ control your hearts; let the word of Christ dwell in you richly.
- 6.15th Your words, Lord, are Spirit and <u>life</u>; you have the words of everlasting <u>life</u>.
- 7.16th Blessed are they who have kept the word with a generous <u>heart</u> and yield a harvest through perse<u>verance</u>.
- 8.17th You have received a Spirit of adoption, through which we cry, Abba, <u>Father</u>.
- 9.18th Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 10.19th Stay awake and be <u>ready!</u> For you do not know on what day your Lord will <u>come</u>.
- 11.4V Blessed are they who hear the word of God and observe it. (Assumption Vigil)
- 12. AD Mary is taken up to <u>heaven</u>; a chorus of angels exults. (Assumption Day)
- 13.20th My sheep hear my voice, says the Lord; I know them, and they follow me.
- 14.21st I am the way, the truth and the life says the <u>Lord</u>;
 - no one comes to the Father except through me.
- 15.22nd Take my yoke upon you says the Lord, and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart.
- 16.23rd Let your face shine on your <u>servant</u>; And teach me your <u>laws</u>.
- 17.24th God was reconciling the world to himself in <u>Christ</u> and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation.
- 18-19.25th, 26th Though our Lord Jesus Christ was rich, he became poor, so that by his poverty you might become rich.
- 20.27th The word of the Lord remains for ever. This is the word that has been proclaimed to you.
- 21.28th In all circumstances, give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.
- 22.29th The word of God is living and effective, discerning reflections and thoughts of the heart.
- 23.30th God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ and entrusting to us the message of salvation.
- 24. As Come to me, all you who labor and are <u>burdened</u>, and I will give you rest, says the <u>Lord</u>. (All Saints)

(Last Sundays in Ordinary Time, cycle c)

- 25.31st God so loved the world that he gave his only <u>Son</u>, so that everyone who believes in him might have eternal life.
- 26.32nd Jesus Christ is the firstborn of the <u>dead</u>; to him be glory and power, for ever and <u>ever</u>.
- 27.33rd Stand erect and raise your <u>heads</u> because your redemption is at <u>hand</u>.
- 28.CK Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!
