The demi-god Maui and his mother, Hina, lived near Waianuenue (Rainbow Falls) in Hilo on the island of Hawai'i. Hina lamented how the sun moved too quickly across the sky to dry the kapa (cloth) she made, as by nightfall the kapa was still damp. Maui devised a plan, and climbed Haleakala, where the sun slept at night. Maui hid until morning and waited for the sun to begin his daily journey. As the first ray of sunshine appeared, Maui snared it with his kaula hei (lasso). The sun demanded to be released, but Maui would not let go. "Promise me that you will move more slowly across the sky," he told the sun. Ensnared, the sun struck a deal; he would move slowly for half of the year, then move more quickly for the other half.
