*After the Sign of the Cross and Greeting, the Presider says:*

**Dear friends, the water blessed at the Easter Vigil will be used to remind us of our baptism. Let us ask God to keep us faithful to the Spirit he has given us.**

*The Presider may walk to the Baptismal Font to add water to the holy water receptacle or may have it with him at the chair. The Presider moves through the church to sprinkle the people.*

*When he returns to the chair, he says:*

**May almighty God cleanse us of our sins, and through the Eucharist we celebrate make us worthy to sit at his table in his heavenly kingdom.**

*The Glory to God follows.*

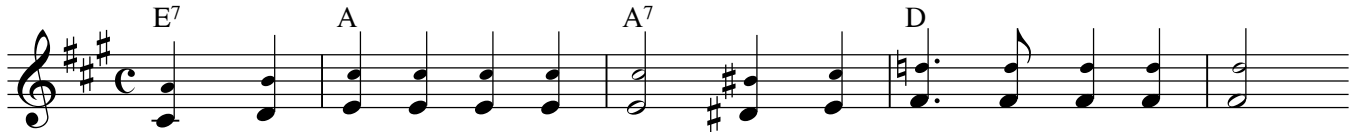
