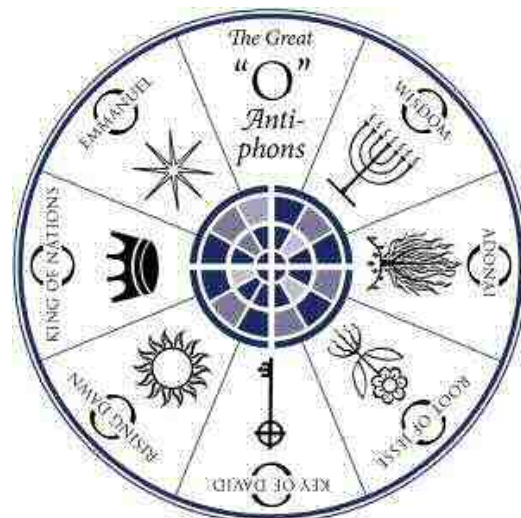

This Advent seasonal psalm expresses the longing that is so characteristic of this season of waiting. The choir may want to improvise harmony for the verses, but keep the antiphon in melodic unison. If the Hawaiian text in the middle of the verses poses a problem, use the English. If you are singing the antiphon *ma ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i*, you may swing the eighths or round them off as triplet quarters. Follow the suggested metronome markings. This setting [as are many settings of Psalm 25] is also quite appropriate for funeral celebrations.
