1. 1st Lent [A,B,C] Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.


2. 2nd Lent [A,B,C] From the shining cloud the Father's voice is heard: this is my beloved Son; hear him.


- 3. 3rd Lent [A] Lord, you are truly the Savior of the world; give me living water, that I may never thirst again.
- 4. 3rd Lent [B] If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.
- 5. 3rd Lent [C] Repent, says the Lord, the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- 6. 4th Lent [A] I am the light of the world, says the Lord: they who follow me will have the light of life.
- 7. 4th Lent [B] God loved the world so much, he gave us his only Son, that all who believe in him might have eternal life.
- 8. 4th Lent [C] I will rise and go to my father and tell him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you.

9. 5th Lent [A] I am the resurrection and the life, said the Lord; they who believe in me will not die forever.

- 10. 5th Lent [B] If you serve me, follow me, says the Lord; and where I am, my servant will also be.
- 11. 5th Lent [C] 4 choices: Rid yourselves of all your sins; and make a new heart and a new spirit.
- 12. I do not wish the sinner to die, says the <u>Lord</u>, but to turn to me and <u>live</u>.
- 13. With all your heart turn to <u>me</u> for I am tender and com<u>pass</u>ionate.
- 14. Seek good and not evil so that you may <u>live</u>, and the Lord will be with <u>you</u>.
- 15. **PASSION**: Christ became obedient for us even to death dying on the <u>cross</u>. Therefore God raised him on high and gave him a name above all other <u>names</u>.
- 16. CHRISM: The spirit of the Lord is upon me; I have been sent to bring Good News to the poor.
- 17. HOLY THURSDAY: I give you a new commandment: love one another as I have loved you.
- 18. **GOOD FRIDAY**: Christ became obedient for us even to death dying on the <u>cross</u>. Therefore God raised him on high and gave him name above all other <u>names</u>.
